

The program will cover emerging science-based research which demonstrates why feeding birds is good for human wellbeing, the physiological changes in our bodies as a result, and testimony of how watching birds has helped healing and finding personal strength during life's challenges.

Credibirdity: Building Industry Trust

Credibirdity focuses on creating collective credibility within the bird feeding industry by relying upon wildlife agencies, conservation organizations, experts, and the Wild Bird Feeding Institute. He will approach industry credibility via three main tenants: incident response, marketing and communications, and production. Attendees will end this presentation with a desire to reflect and review current practices, build a plan for future credibirdity, and establish a foundation of reliable sources.

Nyjer® Does Origination and Sterilization Influence Consumption

WEDNESDAY | 1:00 PM - 2:00 PM

Dr. Horn has been a professor at the college level for over 20 years. He studied how country of origin and location of sterilization influenced consumption of Nyjer® seed. The study took place for eight weeks in late 2021 and early 2022 at three locations in and around Decatur, IL. Four types of Nyjer® were offered representing different combinations of country of origin and site of sterilization. Mean seed consumption per feeder for the four types of Nyjer® ranged from 0.6 lbs per week to 1.1 lbs per week. The study is being replicated this fall and is sponsored by the WBFI.





Avian Diseases & #FEEDSMART Practices

Jenna is a PhD student at the University of New Mexico and the Museum of Southwestern Biology, where she studies evolution, systematics, and natural history of birds in the South Pacific. Diseases in wild bird populations are natural and inevitable. Even so, sometimes our own actions can contribute to the spread of disease within populations of birds that frequent outdoor feeders. Jenna will focus on different sources of diseases that naturally occur within feeder bird populations, including those caused by bacteria, parasites, and viruses. She will also cover ways to communicate with customers on how to feed wild birds while limiting the spread of infectious disease

Winter Finch Migration - Where Will Seed Sales Thrive This Year?

Matt received his B.S. in Water Resources with a minor in Meteorology from SUNY-Oneonta and his M.S. in Ornithology from the SUNY College of Environmental Science and Forestry/Syracuse University in 2003. He was a Regional Editor of the Kingbird for 10 years, the state ornithological journal in New York, was an Adjunct Professor in Environmental Studies at SUNY- Cortland, and currently teaches an Intro to Birding class for Cornell University and is the Board Chair at The Wetland Trust. Matt will be discussing the finch irruptions and their potential correlation with seed sales, forecast, and where the Finch Research Network is headed with the Winter Finch Forecast.




